Emergency Number	You can call 112 from fixed and mobile phones to contact any emergency service: an ambulance, the fire brigade or the police.	
Athens Metro	The closest metro station is <b>Evangelismos</b> which is around 20' by foot.	
Buses	OASA line 4 stops 50m from the apartment and it's 8 stops away (about 20') from the Syntagma Square Metro station.	
Taxi	You can hail a Taxi on the street most hours of the day but there is a Taxi stop at <b>Pl. Nikolaou Plastira</b> , 500m away from the apartment where you can find a Taxi 24/7.

5. Make sure you turn off any hazardous electrical appliances like the oven, iron & kettle before leaving the house.

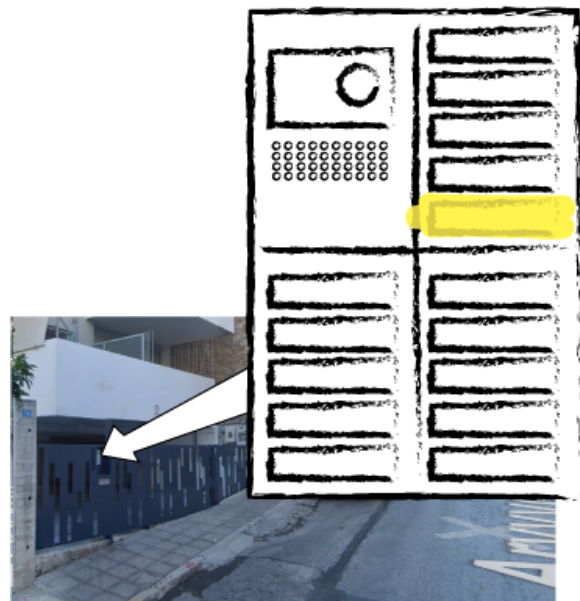
## Check-in & check-out times

We kindly request that guests adhere to our check-in time starting at **14:00** and check-out by **12:00**. Your cooperation in adhering to these times would be greatly appreciated. Should you require a late check-out, please reach out to me. Note however that due to potential same-day check-ins, we may not always be able to accommodate late checkout requests. Your understanding in this matter is greatly appreciated.

## Check-in process

The exterior doors of the building are WiFi operated, you can **press the apartment buzzer** and we will let you in wirelessly. See the diagram on the right for the correct buzzer button to press.

The apartment is on the 6th floor, once there you can find a **lockbox** for your keys right beside the apartment door. You will receive a code for the lockbox at least 48 hours before check in. The keychain contains 2 keys, one key opens the apartment and the other opens the exterior doors.



## Check-out process

While checking out please make sure you haven't left any of your belongings behind. You can leave the keys inside the apartment and close the door.

## Parking Space

The apartment has a private parking space that is available to guests. You can find the garage door key fob next to the tv.

## Emergencies

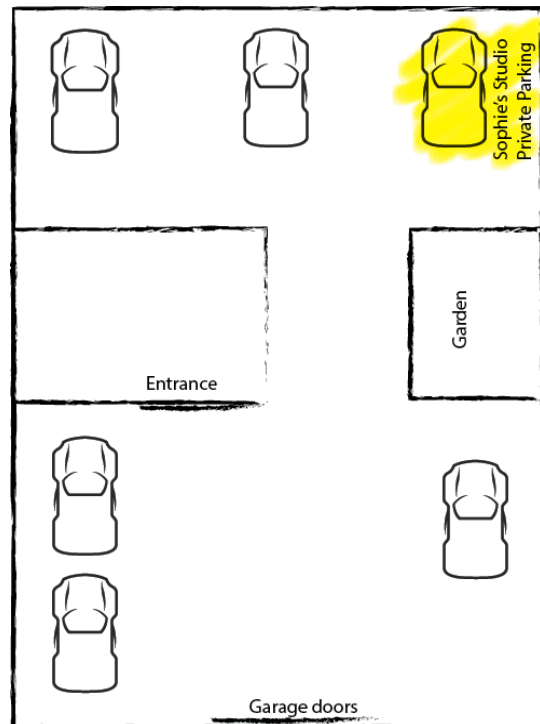
There is a **first aid kit** under the living room table. There is a **fire blanket** and a **fire extinguisher** under the kitchen sink.

## Operating the hot water boiler

To operate the boiler please find the electrical panel on the right of the bathroom door. The boiler button is on the bottom right. Pressing the button will turn on the boiler for 30' or until the boiler is done heating the water. The boiler is located inside the bathroom, there is a gauge on it that shows how much hot water is left. A full boiler is enough for 3 to 4 showers.

## Cleaning supplies

You can find a vacuum cleaner in the leftmost closet door in the bedroom. There's ironing equipment in the rightmost closet door. Cleaning supplies are located under the kitchen sink and you can also find detergents for the washing machine under the bathroom sink.

### **Kallimarmaro**

Kallimarmaro, also known as the Panathenaic Stadium, is an ancient stadium located in Athens, Greece, made entirely of marble. Renowned for hosting the first modern Olympic Games in 1896. **Avoid the main entrance** and visit through the back entrance that leads to the hill surrounding the stadium for a majestic view of the site. Access to the hill is free.
